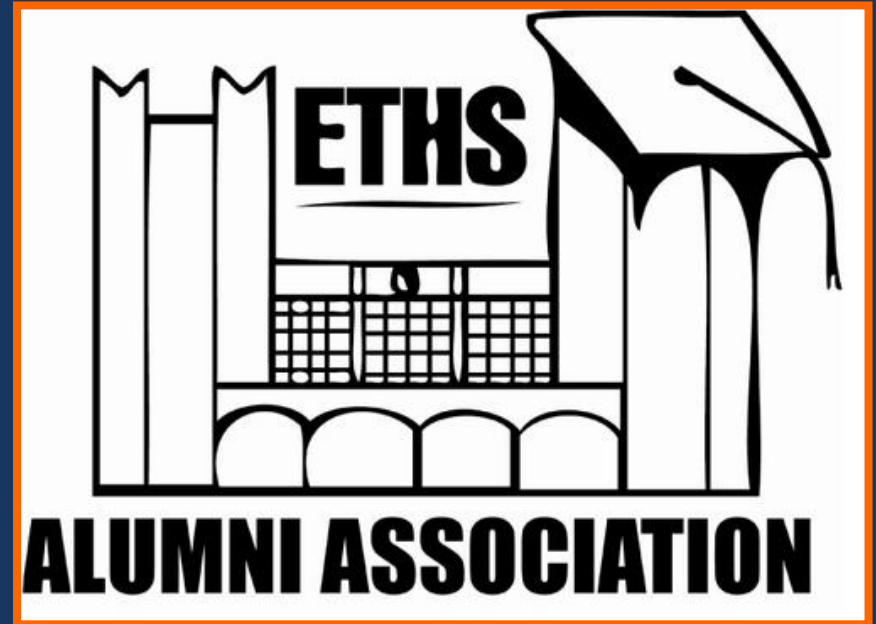

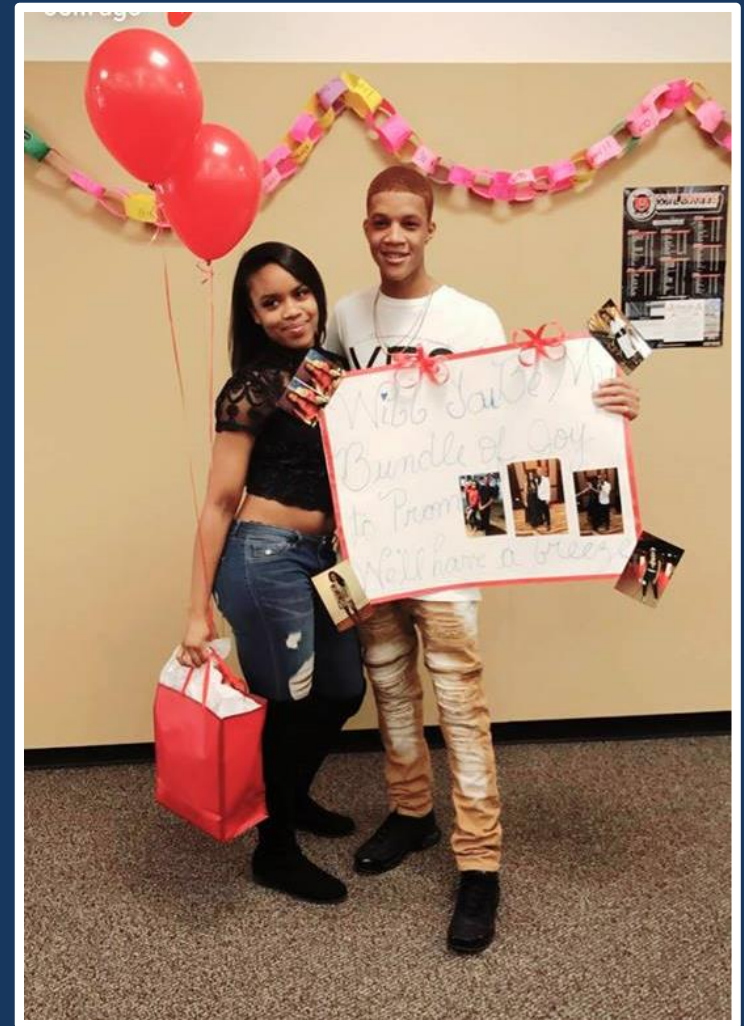
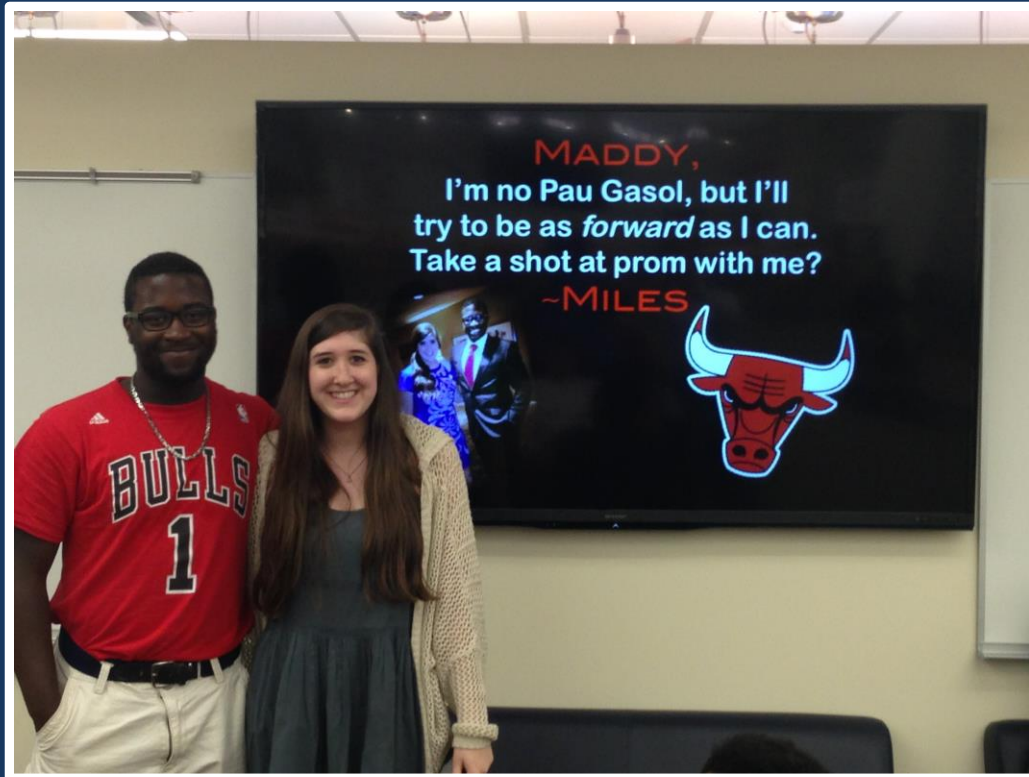

Prom Guests

Guests must be:

- At least Juniors in high school & UNDER 21 years of age
- Juniors may attend by invite of an ETHS Senior only

Guests must have:

- Proof of identification (*check the requirements*)
- A “Prom Guest Approval Form” approved and on file with Dean King by 4:00pm on May 3 (no exceptions)

Seniors are responsible for confirming guest approval on May 10, 4:00pm in the Deans’ Office (H109).

Prom Dinner Options

(Select during registration)

- **Chicken**-Rosemary lemon chicken breast with boursin mashed potatoes and seasonal vegetables
- **Beef**-Port wine short rib with boursin mashed potatoes and seasonal vegetables
- **Vegetarian**-Eggplant Napoleon with spinach, ricotta, cremini mushrooms, and a fresh marinara sauce
- **DIETARY NEEDS- Students with dietary restrictions (gluten free, food allergy, etc.), see Ms. Rosemond in The Hub ASAP!**

- 12:15AM-2:15AM-After-Midnight Prom Party

Prom Registration

1. All SENIORS MUST register **themselves** (and their junior or non-ETHS guest) for prom using myETHS

- Registration is open from 8:00AM on May 10, through 4:00PM on May 13.
- **Seniors MUST register, regardless of payment option**

2. Seniors MUST pay for their ticket AND their junior or non-ETHS guest's ticket

- **Credit cards payments will be accepted online from May 10-13, (during prom registration)**
 - **Bring your receipt to ticket pick-up May 16 & May 17**
 - **Cash payments must be done in The Hub (W220) from May 16-May 17 (after you have registered; during ticket pick-up)**

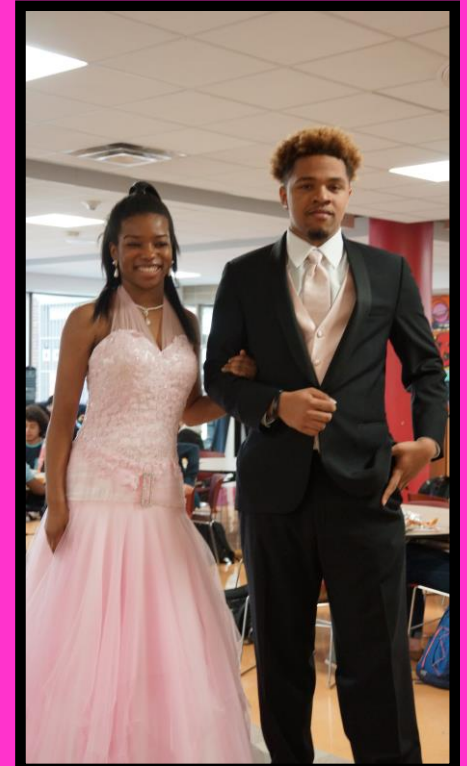

Prom Transportation

- You are responsible for transportation to and from prom
- Rides must be arranged to pick you up no later than 2:30AM (from The Spirit of Chicago)
- Use the EAST lot (to avoid walking VERY far)
- Enter the designated Prom Area & follow the signage to the registration area

Prom Parking

Check-In

7:30pm Students and guests check-in

You MUST have:

1. A current, valid ID (Student ID for ETHS students, State ID or Drivers License for non-ETHS guests – same as submitted on Guest Form)
2. Prom Ticket
3. No purses larger than a clutch (small purse)

Keep clutches, cameras and cell phones with you at all times

(ETHS & Navy Pier are not responsible for lost or stolen items)

ALL students will have to wear a paper wristband

If wristband is removed, you will need to leave Prom and may not enter The Spirit of Chicago Cruise

THIS WRISTBAND IS ALSO YOUR SPIRIT OF CHICAGO TICKET!

Coat Check

- A FREE coat check will be available
- Coat check is available for coats/jacket/bags
- NO bags bigger than a backpack will be permitted at the Coat Check
- Any clutch purses, cameras, cell phones, and valuables must be kept with you at all times
- Bags, purses, and backpacks will be searched

Leaving Prom Early

Each student and guest will receive a Boat Ticket wristband at check-in

If you leave prom before 11:15PM, your boat ticket wristband will be removed, and you will NOT be permitted to go on The Spirit of Chicago Cruise

Breathalyzer Tests & Substance Use

- Students and guests will be randomly breathalyzed, prior to boarding The Spirit of Chicago
- Bags will be searched
- Chicago Police Officers will be at Prom and on the boat
- NO use of e-cigarettes/vapes or tobacco products at Navy Pier (smoking, chew) -this is still a school event
- Possession, consumption, or other use of alcohol or illegal substances before, during, or after prom/cruise is prohibited
- If you or your guest is suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at prom, we will contact your parent/guardian and have you picked up
- Any violations will result in the loss of graduation participation**

Student & Guest Responsibilities

- School rules apply at Prom and aboard The Spirit of Chicago
- Any violation of these Prom Guidelines or school rules will result in your removal from the festivities
- Violation of school rules by the guest or ETHS student may result in arrest, suspension, and being banned from participating in the graduation ceremony
- ETHS students are responsible for their guests' behavior, and consequences for rules violated by guest(s).

Finish Strong

- Protect your privilege to participate in Prom and Graduation
- Refrain from doing anything to compromise your ability to participate in any end-of-the-year events and/or activities
- Make smart, mature, and positive decisions
- Avoid engaging in activities that will place you on Social Probation
- Social Probation=No participation in year-end events
