Individualized Career & Academic Planning

11th Grade: Planning

Step 6: Financial Aid & Scholarships

Financial aid for students & resources to help families better prepare

Step 7: Unique Considerations

Information for families of special needs students, student athletes, highly selective applicants, & undocumented students.

Step 8: Next Steps

Steps students can take starting in the spring of Junior year to be prepared for Senior year.

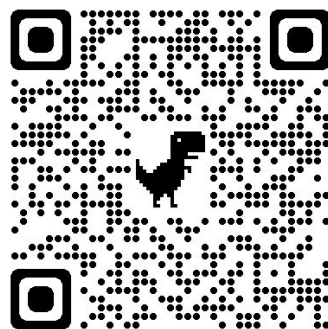
