ETHS Board reviews election, chooses officers

At its May 3 meeting, the ETHS school board reviewed the results of the recent board election and chose its officers for the upcoming year. Three incumbents successfully ran for re-election—Pat Savage-Williams, Pat Maunsell, and Gretchen Livingston—while Jude Laude did not seek re-election, leaving the fourth seat vacant.

Board members re-elected Savage-Williams as President, Monique Parsons as Vice President, and Asst. Supt./Curriculum-Instruction Peter Bavis as Board Secretary, and re-appointed Chief Financial Officer Mary Rodino as School Treasurer.

The board also reviewed results from the ETHS student body election for Student Board Member, which was held by ETHS senior Carmiya Bady this past year. Barbara Tomaradze was elected to fill Bady's post and Eleanor Jones was chosen as alternate for the next school year.

Laude will continue working at the Youth Job Center, which provides work-readiness training, career advice, job placement, and support to youth across Evanston, Chicago, and Cook County.

The process to fill the vacant seat was posted May 4 and is explained on the ETHS website (eths.k12.il.us).

Applicants should submit an application, a cover letter, and a resume by June 1. Interviews will be held during June, and the school board plans to select a new member by June 28.

Board members recognized both Laude and Bady for their service on the ETHS school board. Laude, an ETHS '84 alumnus, thanked his board colleagues for being servant leaders and said he aims to work with ETHS and the City to help graduates solidify their desires and find their future careers. Board members praised Bady for her wisdom and maturity and for sharing her connection with the student community during this difficult pandemic year.

School calendars approved

The school board approved the recommended new calendars for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years.

Noted changes on the 2021-22 school calendar include:

- "Semester Exams" have been removed (Dec. 20-23, 2021, and May 23-27, 2022)

- Non-attendance day is noted on Dec. 24, 2021
- Winter Break is the week of Dec. 27, 2021–Jan. 7, 2022
